◇ **What: Post-9/11 Vets of All Faiths Are Invited to Apply for the 2018 Warriors to Lourdes (WTL) Program at Lourdes, France 15-22 May 2017**

- *Qualified Participants are regional members of the U.S. Delegation to the 60th Annual Military Pilgrimage (PMI) to Lourdes under the Warriors to Lourdes (WTL) Program*
- *Program is **fully funded** by the Catholic Charity, Knights of Columbus (for qualified applicants on first come, first served basis) - caregivers and companions are encouraged to apply*
- *WTL is managed under the auspices of the Archdiocese for the Military Services*
- *WTL pilgrimage is designed to support both vets with disabilities/special needs and/or those not disabled— full U.S. medical staff is on site at Lourdes*

◇ **Where/Who:** Lourdes, France (in the Pyrenees Mountains near the border with Spain), a Catholic pilgrimage site since 1858; visited by over 5 million pilgrims annually who are seeking healing (over 40% of WTL pilgrims are not Catholic)

◇ **When:** PMI-WTL Pilgrimage is from 15-22 May 2017; departs/returns SeaTac

◇ **Why:** An open opportunity to find spiritual development, healing, fellowship and camaraderie with over 20,000 fellow military pilgrims from over 40 countries worldwide
