

STUDENT/YOUTH INJURIES

In the event a student/youth is injured during the course of a school or youth group activity, on or off premises, immediate medical attention should be provided along with appropriate notification to the youth's family or guardian.

A Student/Youth Accident Report detailing the cause and nature of the student's injury should then be completed and submitted to the Risk Management Office.

Student Accident Insurance

- At the beginning of the school year, coverage and registration information for the Student Accident Insurance Program is mailed directly to all Archdiocesan schools by Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Company.
- The information packets should be given to all parents/guardians of all enrolled students.
- If there are questions concerning the coverage or how to file a claim, please contact the Risk Management Office for assistance, or call Myers- Stevens & Toohey & Company directly at 800.827.4695.
- Coverage is excess of any other available medical coverage. However, if the student does not have other health coverage, the insurer will review the claim on a primary basis.
- Schools will be billed directly by the Archdiocese for this coverage, based upon the reported "first day" call in number of students.
- In addition to the Archdiocesan sponsored plans, parents/guardians may enroll their child in any one of the other optional benefits available from the Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Company plan. See the coverage brochure for information.
- The policy may provide coverage for expenses not covered under the youth's primary coverage.
