

The 2018 Holy Days of Obligation for the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon are:

- The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Wednesday 15th August 2018
- All Saints – Thursday 1st November 2018
- The Immaculate Conception of the BVM* – Saturday 8th December 2018
- The Nativity of the Lord – Tuesday 25th December

Notes:

Mary Mother of God – 1st January 2018 is not a Holyday of Obligation

The Ascension of the Lord is transferred to Sunday 13th May

**Immaculate Conception is always a Holyday of Obligation in USA unless transferred to another date.*

“In addition to Sunday, the days to be observed as holydays of obligation in the Latin Rite dioceses of the USA include the following solemnities: **Mary, Mother of God** (*January 1*); the **Ascension of the Lord**; the **Assumption of Mary** (*August 15*); **All Saints** (*November 1*); the **Immaculate Conception of Mary** (*December 8*); and **Christmas** (*December 25*).

“Whenever January 1, the solemnity of **Mary, Mother of God**, *or* August 15, the solemnity of the **Assumption of Mary**, *or* November 1, the solemnity of **All Saints**, falls on a Saturday or a Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted.”

2019 Holydays of Obligation for the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon.

- Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God – Tuesday 1st January 2019
- The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Thursday 15th August 2019
- All Saints – Friday 1st November 2019
- The Nativity of the Lord – Wednesday 25th December 2019

Notes:

The Ascension of the Lord is transferred to Sunday 2nd June

The Immaculate Conception of BVM is always a Holyday of Obligation in USA unless it is transferred to another date. This year it is transferred to the 9th December since it falls on the Second Sunday of Advent (8th December 2019). The obligation does not transfer.
